For applicants aspiring for Oxford, Cambridge and other top universities, the Oxford University Pembroke College Summer Programme, designed and taught entirely by Oxford University admissions tutors and lecturers, is one of the most valuable and immersive experiences they can have.

As the only established degree subject-specific summer programme for secondary students officiated by an Oxford admissions college, the programme is open to students who intend to study Bio-medical Sciences or Law. ARCH Education Center (ARCH), the Sole Representative of the programme in the Greater China region, is responsible for the selective recruitment and the final round of interviews, while the College makes the final decision on offers.

Giles Henderson, the recently retired Master of Oxford University Pembroke College, attests to the success through the "authentic Oxford academic experience". He explained, "There are many study tours and summer programmes hosted by third parties at Oxford and Cambridge Universities. What makes the Pembroke Oxford programme stand out is that it is hosted and run by the College itself".

John Eekelaar, Programme Director and Law Tutor for forty years in Oxford as well as a former Rhodes Scholar and Emeritus Fellow of Pembroke College, explains the structure of this unique program: "The Programme delivers a combination of lectures and tutorials given by established Oxford academics in the same way as is provided for Oxford undergraduates, reflecting the low teacher-student ratio, the devoted resources towards each student and the quality of highly intellectual discussions".

Wharton Chan, a past student who was later accepted into Oxford with a scholarship, enthused, "The courses were truly rewarding, both in its content and insight from the professors. Students are being brought to the forefront of current research, with lectures on latest discoveries of the professors' area of specialty".

Jennifer Ma, co-founder of ARCH, explained the application process: "During our interview, we ask open-minded questions to ascertain students' critical and lateral thinking ability as well as their capacity to be stretched intellectually". Beyond high academic achievement, final candidates are expected to have a high awareness of global issues and applications beyond textbooks.

Ma concluded, "Ultimately, we want to ascertain whether we feel they will truly benefit from the programme".
